## **TODAY'S OUTREACH OPPORTUNITIES FUND RECIPIENT**

From November, 2023 to February, 2024, our Outreach Opportunities Fund recipient will be the <u>Food Stash</u> <u>Foundation</u>. Food Stash Foundation has a twofold mission: **to prevent good food from going to waste and provide dignified food access to promote a thriving planet and a healthy community.** We collect over 100,000 pounds of food per month that would have gone to waste, deliver to 35 charity partners, deliver Rescued Food Boxes to 100 plus households and serve 140 rescued food market members.
